Entry fee of \$30 both in advance and day of. Entry fee is non-refundable. Entrants may register as many legal fish as you like, regardless of species. 100% total payout. Cash prizes will be paid out based on the number of entrants at 1st place 45%, 2nd place 25%, 3rd place 15%, 4th place 10%, 5th place 5%. Winning entrant will be determined by total length. The accumulated length of all legal fish registered by each entrant, will be summed to achieve the total length measured to the nearest 1/8" for each entrant registering fish. 2019 Lucky's on the Lake 5th Annual Ice Fishing Tournament Rules



Listed below are the contest rules for the 2019 Ice Fishing Tournament. Rules may be subject to change. All decisions by Tournament Officials are final.

- 1. Fish eligible for the Ice Fishing Tournament must be caught on Lake Wisconsin, WI during the contest hours of 6:30AM 3:30PM on Saturday February 9, 2019.
- 2. Participants registering the day-of the event (6:30 7:30 AM at Lucky's) may not register any fish caught prior to registration for the event.
- 3. All participants registering fish must be back and checked in by 3:30PM.
- 4. Winning fish will be determined by total length. The cumulative length of all legal fish registered by each entrant, will be summed to achieve the Total Length measured to the nearest 1/8" for each entrant registering fish. Entrants may register as many legal fish as you like, while observing legal limits <u>AND</u> tournament minimum lengths, regardless of species. <u>100% total payout</u>. Cash prizes will be paid out based on the number of entrants at 1st place 45%, 2ND place 25%, 3rd place 15%, 4th place 10%, 5th place 5%. There will also be a prize awarded for BIG FISH. Lucky's will also be taking donations for the Lake Wisconsin Alliance <u>www.lakewisconsinalliance.org</u>. Additional prizes, drawings & raffles will be awarded/available to entrants at Lucky's on the Lake in Okee after the tournament closing time of 3:30PM.
- 5. Any tampering with length of fish will automatically disqualify angler from contest.
- 6. Officials shall have the right to verify that fish were legally caught. The decisions of the Officials are final. In the event deception is detected his/her prize will be forfeited and will be disqualified.
- 7. All fishing regulations for Lake Wisconsin will be abided by. Any illegally caught fish will be disqualified.
- 8. All laws of the State of Wisconsin will be abided by.
- 9. Failure to comply with any contest rules subjects contestants to disqualification and removal from competition, as determined by contest officials. Right to refuse competition to anyone is hereby reserved.
- 10. Minimum lengths to register by species for the tournament are as follows: **Perch** 7" minimum 25 total panfish applies

Bluegill or Sunfish – 6" minimum 25 total panfish applies

Walleye or Sauger -15" minimum 5 total (SLOT LIMIT IS IN EFFECT) Walleyes or saugers measuring 20" to 28" are protected and not legal to keep. 1 walleye over 28" may be kept, but contributes toward the daily bag limit of 5 walleyes and / or saugers.

Northern Pike – 26" minimum 2 total

White Bass – 9" minimum

Crappie - 9" minimum 25 total Panfish applies

Largemouth and Smallmouth bass – 15" minimum 5 total

Catfish - 14" minimum - 10 total
