Public Hearing Scheduled for WisDOT's I-39/90/94 Wisconsin River Bridge Project

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) will be holding a public hearing to discuss the proposed improvements to the I-39/90/94 bridge over the Wisconsin River.

The proposed improvement would include:

- Replacement of the existing I-39/90/94 Wisconsin River bridge with a new bridge that would accommodate construction staging, future maintenance work and future traffic needs.
- Replacement of the County U and County V bridges over I-39/90/94.
- Construction of retaining walls to avoid impacts to transmission structures.

There will be no relocation of persons or businesses as a result of the proposed improvement.

There will be two opportunities to attend the public hearing for this project—one component held virtually online, and one component held in-person.

In consideration of the COVID-19 pandemic, it is encouraged that the public participate in the process through the virtual public hearing component to the extent possible. However, all interested persons are invited to attend one or both public hearing components. Both public hearing components will allow for recording of public and private testimony.
